The purpose of the Palmerston Young Writers Competition is to encourage and promote young writers, with interests in creative literacy, by providing an opportunity to showcase their talents.

RULES

- The Writing Competition is open to students living in or attending school in the Palmerston and Rural areas
- Entries Open NOW
- Entries close 11th June 2021 (Week 8 of Term 2)
- All written and visual entries submitted are to be the original work of the student. Teachers may assist students with brainstorming ideas and final proofreading only
- Entrants are eligible to enter more than one piece of writing in all categories
- Written category entries will be judged by the Palmerston's Own Writers Group
- Visual Writing category entries will be judged by the Palmerston Library
- Winners will be notified through the school representative (where student attends Palmerston/Rural school)
- Winners will be invited to the Awards Presentation in Term 3
- By submitting an entry, permission is given for written work and name of author to be displayed, published or promoted by Palmerston Young Writer's Festival and sponsors of the event.

Visual Writing Entries:

Poem - Year 2 only
